Section 5(b)

### STATEMENT OF PURPOSES

1. The name of the proposed incorporated association is The Systems Administrators Guild of Australia, Incorporated.

2. The purposes for which the proposed incorporated association is established are:--

(a) to promote interaction between professional systems administrators within Australia and throughout the world;

(b) to advance the state of knowledge and level of excellence in the profession;

(c) to provide professional education for its members; and

(d) to provide recognition to high achievers amongst its members.

3. Solely for the purpose of furthering those purposes set out above, the Association shall have power to:--

(a) invest and deal with moneys of the Association not immediately required, in such a manner as is from time to time thought fit;

(b) raise or borrow money upon such terms and in such manner as it thinks fit;

(c) secure the repayment of moneys so raised or borrowed or the payment of a debt or liability of the Association by giving a security interest upon or over all or any of the property of the Association;

(d) do all such other things as are incidental or conducive to the attainment of the purposes and the exercise of the powers of the Association.
